

【Payments Required After Arrival】

◀ Staying at Wakakusa Dormitory ▶

- Payment of dormitory fees for the first semester (Payment due in May or June. Please make sure to have sufficient funds available. Payment cannot be made by credit card.)
- Food expenses
- Daily necessities
- Electricity fee
- Betting fee

◀ Staying in an Apartment ▶

- Deposit and rent (One month's rent must be paid at the time of move-in. Even if you plan to cover the rent with part-time job income, it may take time to find a job. Therefore, it is advisable to prepare at least three months' worth of rent and utility expenses in advance.)
- Electricity, water, and gas bills
- Food expenses
- Daily necessities

【Items to Bring from Your Home Country】

★ Traditional Clothing or a Suit (if you do not have traditional clothing)

- Dress code for the Entrance Ceremony and the Degree Conferral Ceremony (Graduation Ceremony)

Formal attire is required. Please wear either traditional clothing or a suit.

If it is cold, you may wear a coat, jumper, or jacket over your formal attire.

- There will be a cultural introduction session.

In addition to traditional clothing, please bring any items you would like to use to introduce your culture. If the items are bulky, photos are acceptable instead of physical items.

★ Personal Seal (Inkan)

If you have ordered one through our university, you do not need to bring one.

★the LINE App

Please download the LINE app to your smartphone before leaving your home country.

★National Health Insurance and the Co-op International Student Insurance

You will need to enroll in these insurance programs.

- National Health Insurance: The annual insurance premium can be paid in 10 installments.
- Co-op International Student Insurance: JPY 13,160 per year (payment will be made shortly after your arrival at the university).
